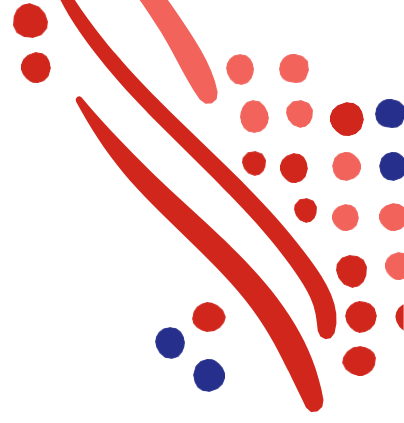


Important information on myGov



The Australian Taxation office (ATO) will be expanding on the information reported as part of Single Touch Payroll. Now that your Employer has moved over to the latest version of Single Touch Payroll V2 (STP V2), this guide provides an overview on STP and what some of the changes means to you.

What is Single Touch Payroll?

STP allows your income, tax and superannuation information to be reported to the ATO every time you get paid.

Prior to STP your income, tax and superannuation information were reported to the ATO at the end of each financial year.

How does the change to STP V2 affect me?

Each time you get paid you are able to see in real time your year-to-date income, tax and superannuation information via your myGov account. As part of the ATO's expansion of STP V2 you will also have the benefits of:

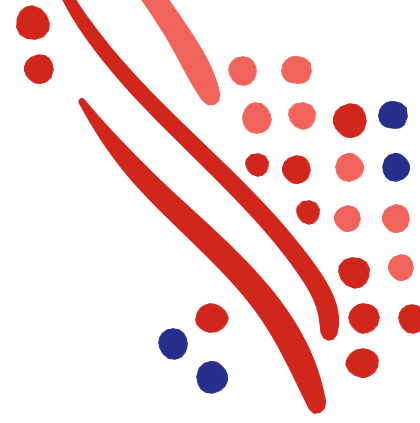
- Income statements showing a breakdown of payments making it easier to read and understand
- More pre-filling of individual income tax returns making tax time easier and understandable
- Less paperwork and more digital records
- Details will be shared with Services Australia who use the information to help with reporting of employment income.

How do I access my Income Statement and view my year-to-date information in myGov?

To access your Income Statement and view your year-to-date information, log into myGov at my.gov.au select ATO online services and follow the prompts.

I don't have access to myGov. How do I create an account?

It's easy to set up and manage a myGov account. All you need is a mobile number and email address.

What happens if I don't want to have a myGov account?

It's not compulsory to have a myGov account, however you won't be able to access your Income Statement or see your year-to-date information without one.
